UNIVERSITY NO. SPN-24 OF 16 APRIL 2024 “ON THE APPROVAL OF THE
COMPOSITION OF THE CENTRAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION OF VILNIUS
UNIVERSITY”**

In accordance with Article 33(1)(26) of the Statute of Vilnius University, Item 10(6) of the Regulations of the Central Electoral Commission of Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. S-2014-3-3 of 20 May 2014 “On the Approval of the Regulations of the Central Electoral Commission of Vilnius University” (wording of Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-49 of 18 June 2024), and Item 12 of the Description of the Procedure for the Election of the Members of the Senate of Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. S-2014-3-9 of 20 May 2014 “On the Approval of the Description of the Procedure for the Election of the Members of the Senate of Vilnius University” (wording of Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-5 of 17 February 2026), the Senate of Vilnius University

hereby decides to amend Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-24 of 16 April 2024 “On the Approval of the Composition of the Central Electoral Commission of Vilnius University” and recast Item 1 as follows:

“1. To approve the composition of the Central Electoral Commission of Vilnius University (hereinafter the ‘Commission’):

1.1. Dr Johanas Baltrimas, Associate Professor at the Department of Public Law of the Faculty of Law (Chairperson of the Commission);

1.2. Dr Rūta Levulienė, Associate Professor at the Institute of Applied Mathematics of the Faculty of Mathematics and Informatics (Deputy Chairperson of the Commission);

1.3. Dr Aidas Alaburda, Professor at the Institute of Bioscience of the Life Sciences Center;

1.4. Linas Gelūnas, Senior Lawyer at the Legislative Division of the Central Administration;

1.5. Dr Inga Leonavičiūtė, Researcher at the Department of Theory of History and History of Culture of the Faculty of History;

1.6. Dr Gintautas Stankūnavičius, Associate Professor at the Institute of Geosciences of the Faculty of Chemistry and Geosciences;

1.7. Dr Tomas Šalkus, Associate Professor at the Institute of Applied Electrodynamics and Telecommunications of the Faculty of Physics;

1.8. Dr Skaistė Volungevičienė, Associate Professor at the Institute for the Languages and Cultures of the Baltic of the Faculty of Philology;

1.9. two student representatives delegated following the procedure set out by the Vilnius University Students’ Representation.”
